IRCS BLOOD BANK :

The Red Cross Blood Bank situated in the premises of Government Lady Goschen Hospital which is serving 24x7 gives blood free of cost to all the needy patients of Lady Goschen Hospital. As such 2972 Blood Units have been given free of cost to the patients during the year under report.

- (a) Voluntary Blood Donation Camps are organised across the district as per the norms of the Department of Drug Control.
- (b) Testing of blood, grouping and cross matching are done as per the NACO guidelines.
- (c) Supervision is done by conducting staff meetings by Medical Officer of our Blood Bank Dr. Rachana Kiran Koppalkar under the able guidance of Dr. U.V. Shenoy, Chairman, IRCS Blood Bank Sub-Committee.
- (d) IRCS Blood Bank Sub-Committee meets in regular intervals to review the performance.
